



The Shrubbery School SATS Results 2016

Our Year 6 children take part in the externally marked SATs testing every year. The format and expectations of testing has changed and there is an up scaled curriculum.

Test results this year, the government advises, cannot be compared to previous years.

In the externally marked papers children are assessed as to whether they have met the expected score for a child in their age group. There has been much speculation as to how these scores have been decided as the national averages are below the expected scores!

Please note that we only have 34 pupils in Year 6 so our percentages are rounded down or up as appropriate. One child equates to around 3%

The government originally stipulated that 65 % of children nationally should achieve expected levels for their age in combined Reading, Writing and Mathematics. This level was not met nationally with 53% of children actually attaining this standard.
